Competition/race rules

The race rules (hereinafter: the Regulations) apply to the Kis-Balaton Kör Running Race to be held on 18 and 19 September 2021, the main organizer of which is Zalakaros Futrinkák SE, hereinafter: the Organizer.

The Rules have been created by the Organizer in order to ensure the smooth running of the race, to inform the Competitors and to implement a sport-like race.

The Organizer announces races on the 700 m, 1400 m, 2800 m, 3 km, 5 km, 6 km, 10 km, 21 km and 35 km distances on the routes marked by the organizer. There is no minimum age for participation in the 700 m, 1400 m, 2800 m, 3 km, 5 km distances of the running races. However, all Competitors under the age of 18 must fill in the parental consent form and submit or sign at the start upon receipt of the race bib number. The minimum age for the 35 km distance and relays is 18 years, the minimum age for the 21 km distance is 14 years, and the minimum age for the 6 and 10 km distances is 10 years.

In the event of drastic weather that makes it impossible for the race to go ahead safely, the Organizer will send a notice and the event will be held at a later time. If as a result of the coronavirus pandemic, the government decides that we must postpone the competition, the entry fees will be carried forward by the organizer to next year's competition. In such cases of force majeure, the Organizer shall not be obliged to reimburse the entry fees.

Age groups:

September 18:

Children's and family running race with the support of the Szabadics for Children Foundation

- 2800 m: 0-5,99 years; 6-9,99 years; 10 – 13,99 years
- 1400 m: 0-5,99 years; 6-9,99 years
- 700 m: 0-5,99 years; 6-9,99 years

Dog run: no age group classification

September 19:

- 35 km relay (11 km – 13 km – 11 km): in women's and men's category, over 18-year olds can participate, mixed teams are evaluated in men's category, no age group classification
- 35 km: 18 -29,99 years, 30 – 50 years, 50+
- 21 km: 14 – 17,99 years; 18 -29,99 years, 30 – 50 years, 50+
- 10 km: 10 – 13,99 years; 14 – 17,99 years; 18 – 29,99 years, 30 – 50 years, 50+
- 6 km: 10 – 13,99 years; 14 – 17,99 years; 18 – 29,99 years, 30 – 50 years, 50

The Organizer reserves the right to change the categories based on the receipt of entries.

Entry process:

- The Organizer provides both online pre-registration and on-site registration. There is no maximum number of entries.
- Pre-registration is considered to be the registration submitted on zalakaros.sportey.hu and the payment of the registration fee. The Organizer will receive pre-registrations from May 1, 2021 to August 20, 2021 at 11:59 p.m. Pre-registrations takes place in three time phases.
- Pre-registrations will take place in two stages: from 1 May 2021 to 30:59 on 30 June 2021; From July 1, 2021 to August 20, 23:59.
- On-site registration is available at the following times:
- September 17 (Friday) from 1 pm to 6 pm in the lobby of the Zalakaros Event Centre (Zalakaros, Szőlő street 16.)
- September 18 (Saturday) from 12 to 17.00 in the hall of the Zalakaros Event Centre (Zalakaros, Szőlő street 16.)
- September 19 (Sunday) from 8 am to 9.30 am in the lobby of the Zalakaros Event Centre (Zalakaros, Szőlő street 16.)
- Both pre-registered Competitors and Competitors registering on-site may receive the start number at the times and locations designated for the on-site registration, within the time frame open for on-site registrations.

Filling in the registration form, submitting the entry:

- The Organizer provides an online entry form for pre-registration.
- Participants under the age of 18 must have declaration of liability completed by a parent or guardian, which can be downloaded from the entry area.
- The declaration of liability can be downloaded from the entry interface. Entrants are kindly requested to bring the completed and signed declaration with them, if this is not possible, the organizers can provide a limited number of declarations on site, but completing this on site will slow down the receipt of the start number.

- If a competitor under the age of 18 arrives without a parent or guardian, please download the declaration of liability, and submit it to us on the day of the competition.
- If an applicant under the age of 18 does not have a declaration of liability signed by a parent or guardian, participation in the competition may be refused.
- By entering the Competitor online, the Organizer will automatically accept the entry of the Competitor by clicking on the "Submit Pre-Application" button, so no other transmission is required.
- It is not possible to sign an online entry form, without a signature, it will take effect at the same time as accepting the declaration contained therein. The organizer requests that the completed, signed declaration of liability be brought by the competitor on the day of the competition.
- Entry becomes final by paying the entry fee by bank transfer!
- By submitting the entry, the entrant accepts the competition rules and the privacy notice at the same time.

Entry fee rate and payment:

- The entry fee can be paid by bank transfer from 1 May 2021. The participant's status becomes active after the receipt of the payment. If the competitor would like a technical T-shirt, then its price will be added to the final amount to be paid. After submitting the registration, the entry fee must be paid by bank transfer to the following bank account: UniCredit Bank 10918001-00000113-50810007
 - When making a transfer, please indicate the name and distance of the participant in the comments.
 - An invoice will be issued by the organizer no later than 5 days after the receipt of the transfer.
- If the Competitor does not participate in the running competition and notifies it no later than 23:59 on August 20, 2021 before the competition, then the Organizer will refund 100% of the entry fee to the Competitor. After August 20, 2021, at 0:00, due to the finalization of the start packages, this is no longer possible.
- If the Competitor has paid the entry fee but does not take part in the running race due to any circumstances, the Organizer will not refund the entry fee from 0:00 on 20 August 2021 due to the finalization of administrations and stocks.
- If the pre-registered competitor wants to change the distance after the pre-registration deadline or at the competition, a handling fee of HUF 1,000 will be charged. The Organizer will provide the competitor with a new start number.
- **If the pre-registered competitor does not pay the pre-registration fee by the pre-registration deadline (20 August 2021 at 23:59), their entry will be automatically deleted from the system!**

- If a competitor wishes to change from a smaller distance to a larger one, the difference in entry fees will be charged. In case of switching from a larger distance to a smaller distance, the Organizer will not be able to refund the difference.
- Moving the pre-registration to another person, is only possible until 23:59 on August 20, 2021 due to the finalization of the bib numbers.

The entry fee includes:

- participation in the race - on a route with traffic restrictions
- Unique medals for each runner finishing their race
- bib number
- chip timing
- warm-up
- awarding winners with medals
- water, isotonic drink, fruit, etc. at the refreshment points.
- cycling and escorting at the front
- Use of toilets and changing rooms
- Refreshments at the finish
- start package (only on race day on September 19)
- online list of results
- Photos published on the Internet
- on-site medical supervision (only on the race day of September 19)
- Refreshing massage for those running 21 km and 35 km (on site)
- During the competition (September 17-19, 2021), one free entry to the Zalakaros Bath/Spa (includes a complex ticket) (only for entrants to the competition on September 19)
- **For the doggy run, the entry fee includes one main entry (owner) and chip timing. One person can enter with several dogs, but in this case, only the services mentioned above are included in the entry fee!**

Discounts:

- If you have a Spuri Gold Card, the Organizer will provide a discount of HUF 500 on the entry fee for each distance. When submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee, Spuri Gold Card membership must be confirmed!
- For the Kanizsa Running Club, Zalakarosi Futrinkak and for the residents from Zalakaros (certified with an address card), the Organizer provides a HUF 1,000 discount on the individual entry fee.

- Discounts cannot be combined, do not apply to races and relays starting on September 18th!

Result announcement:

- ALL CATEGORIES 1-3. its winners (boy-girl, man-woman) will receive a medal award.
- Relay mixed teams are evaluated in the men's category.
- The first 3 places in the Children's and Family competition will be awarded a medal.
- Out of the dogs participating in the doggy run, the first 3 placed dog and its owner will receive a medal. If 2 or more dogs compete with 1 owner, only 1 dog will be awarded.
- Valuable prizes will be drawn after the awards ceremony for both 6 and 10 km runners and 21 and 35 km runners. The draw will be based on the bib numbers, among those who successfully complete the distances.

Route:

- The organizer designates and publishes routes for 700 m, 1400 m, 2800 m, 3 km, 5 km, 6 km, 10 km, 21 km and 35 km race distances.
- The Organizer provides orientation signs and arrows painted on the road surface (direction signs, buoys, etc.). Volunteers, civil guards and police officers ensure the safe and undisturbed passage of the sections of the route with traffic and intersections.
- The Organizer places refreshment points
- The competition is a cupless competition, so the Organizer does not provide plastic cups at any of the refreshment points. The competitors are asked to bring a recyclable cup, bottle, etc. that they can fill for themselves.
- The progress of the Competitors along the route will be monitored by the Organizer in several places.
- The Organizer will provide a bike ride in front of the Competitors, and will check the route by bike or car after the last Competitor passing by.
- The routes of each distance will be published by the Organizer on social media and on the website before the competition.
- Distances are characterized by slight uphill and downhill

Refreshment Points:

Refresh points will be available outside the start / finish area at multiple locations at all times:

- 6 km: 1 refresh point

- 10 km: 2 refresh points
- 21 km: 3 refresh points
- 35 km: 7 refresh points

Refreshment points will usually be located at the relay changing points.

Refreshment points are also provided for dogs on sept 18.

The competition is a cupless competition, so the Organizer does not provide any plastic or paper cups at any of the refresh points, so competitors are asked to bring a soft cup, bottle, etc. that they can fill for themselves. Refresh points will have longer tables to avoid possible congestion.

The organizers provide soft cup rental and purchase in the competition center, the cost of which is uniformly HUF 1,500.

Other information:

- A participant can only register to run one distance.
- On September 18, a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 people can enter the family competition, of which a minimum of one must be under 14 years of age.
- In the family competition, the time result of the last runner is taken into account.
- Relay information: minimum 2 people, maximum 3 people to complete the 35km distance. The changeover points are 11km - 13km - 11km away. The first runner can also be entered into an individual running race. In the case of 2 people running the relay, the person running 2 distances must be specified. The organizer gives the participants the opportunity that the person who completes the 35 km individually can also be the first person of the relay (in this case they would have 2 bib numbers). Team members will have a bib number that must be passed on to the next runner when changing over. The organizer provides the equipment to fixate the bib numbers! Mixed teams will be judged in the men's category! Only people over the age of 18 can take part in the relay, there is no age group classification! Teams must make sure that they are able to get their participants to the changeover points.
- The bib number must be placed to the front of the T-shirt in a clearly visible place. Entrants can pick up their bib number along with the safety pins.
- The Organizer will exclude the Competitor from the running competition if they do not fill in the entry form according correctly (eg time of birth), folds the bib number, covers it, does not put it on the T-shirt, shows unsportsmanlike conduct towards other runners (intentional pushing, punching, etc.).
- For the duration of the competition (from the start of pre-entries to the announcement of the results) both the Organizer and the Competitor are obliged to consider themselves binding, regardless of whether the Competitor has signed the entry form or not (electronic entry form and paper entry form). both).
- The Organizer reserves the right to change the route, program and time!

- The aim of the Competition Rules is to create a sporty atmosphere in the competition, to ensure the safety and protection of the competitors and to raise the standard of the competition.
- Smoking during sport is incompatible with the spirit of competition, so smoking is strictly prohibited in the race and in the finish area to protect non-smokers. A competitor who, despite the prohibition, smokes during the competition in the competition area, refreshment point, switching point or Start and Finish Area will be excluded from the competition and their bib number will be taken back by the Organizer.
- The race is a road running race, there will be no road closures, everyone will take part in the event at their own risk, following the rules of KRESZ. Minors need parental consent, with a signature!
- Parking is available close to the Start - Finish area (parking is free in Zalakaros).
- The bus station is located 50 m from the event venue.
- Luggage storage, dressing and toilet facilities are provided by the Organizer near the venue.
- Starting this year, the competition has joined the Ötpróba community, so it is also possible to collect points with our competition numbers. The following points can be collected in the following distances: 6km - 2 points; 10 km - 3 points; 21 km - 4 points; 35 km - 6 points; 35 km relay - 4 points; You can read more about the Ötpróba at <https://otprobatokioba.hu/>.

Statement:

- As a participant of the Kis-Balaton Kör Running Competition, I accept and comply with the contents of the competition rules.
- I acknowledge that I participate in the competition at my own risk.
- Certain stages of the race will be held on the road, to which the rules of the Traffic Act apply. I declare that I will strictly follow the rules of the TRAFFIC and the instructions of the Organizer during the competition!
- I declare that I know the peculiarities of the competition, the length, the elevation, and the difficulty of the chosen distance, I am adequately prepared to complete the distance.
- I declare that I am in a state of health suitable for competition, the Organizer is not responsible for any injuries, accidents, or damage to health during the competition!
- I acknowledge that the Organizer is not responsible for any damage caused by my own unpreparedness, negligence, or carelessness in connection with the competition.
- I acknowledge that the Organizer does not take out insurance for entrants, all competitors must arrange this themselves outside of the competition.

- In the case of a participant under the age of 18, the legal representative is solely responsible for the fulfilment of the conditions described above, which is confirmed by a separate signature.
- I acknowledge that if the competition cannot be held at the announced date/time due to the weather or natural disaster, the Organizer reserves the right to change the program, location, and track.
- The information provided when I applied is accurate and I consent to its storage and use at the event. The organizer can send a newsletter and a text message to the address and telephone number provided by me.
- The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants, closing the entry at any time.
- The organizer is not responsible for personal belongings or property placed at the competition venue.
- I declare that I will follow the safety instructions of the Organizer and the staff providing the event. I agree that a competitor who competes without a bib number will be disqualified. Leaving or shortening the course also entails exclusion. I do not claim damages from the Organizer and the organizers in case of injury.
- At the same time as my entry, I agree that a photo, ie a photo and / or video recording (hereinafter: a photo) may be taken of me at the event, which the Organizer - or a third party appointed by the Organizer - is entitled to. , youtube, online website banners, electronic newsletter, event gallery -, unlimited use in terms of method and extent of use. The method of use includes, but is not limited to, the processing, distribution, reproduction, communication to the public, recording and storage on a data carrier of the image, and the transfer of the use of the image to a third party. By participating in the event, I acknowledge without notice that the consent cannot be revoked due to its possible disclosure and internet technology, any restrictions on it will only bind the holder (s) for the period after the statement of prohibition, and I irrevocably declare that I do not claim any remuneration for the use rights detailed above or for my consent to the use and disclosure of the image.
- In the Doggy Run, the owner takes full responsibility for the dog. The competitor can take part in the race by keeping the dog on a leash and observing all safety regulations, and by applying he undertakes that the dog has fulfilled all the obligations associated with vaccinations and animal husbandry, the dog has the prescribed vaccinations.

The organizers provide soft cup rental and purchase in the competition center, the cost of which is uniformly HUF 1,500.
